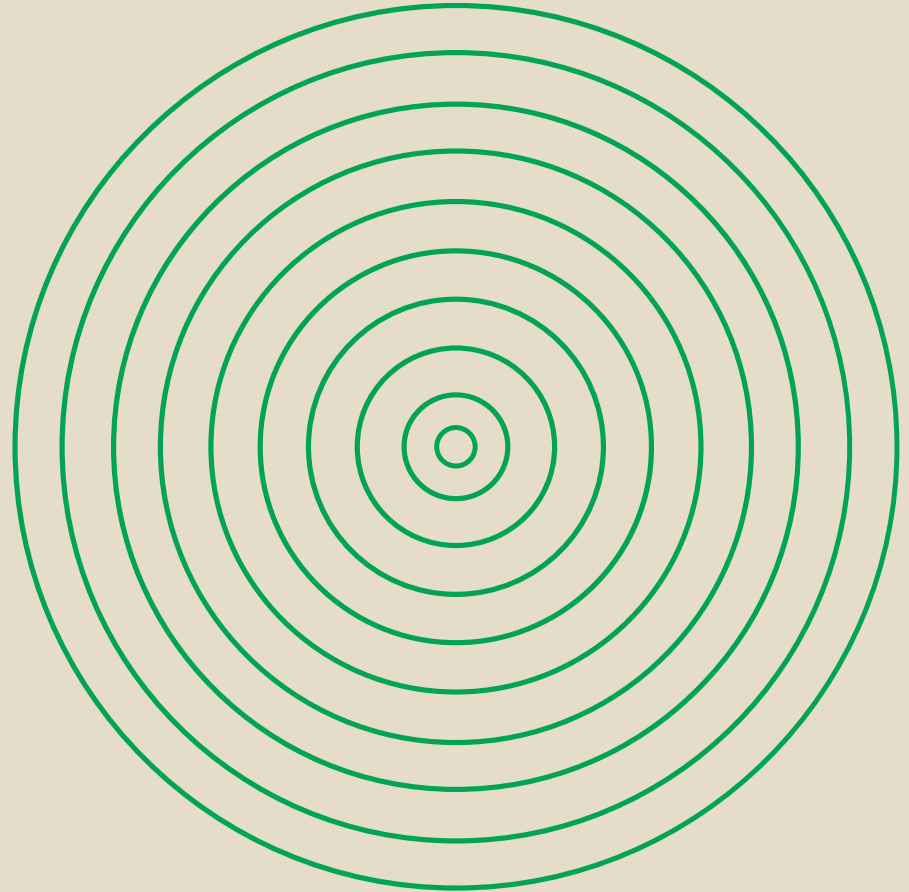
Engage in the Development of UL Standards

 - Review and comment on proposals for testing requirements, hazard analyses, etc.
